

A Simple Call to Salvation

Jesus Christ declared,

Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life ~John 6:47 AKJB.

To receive salvation, you must believe in Jesus Christ and follow His teachings:

If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free ~John 8:31-32 AKJB.

Faith in Christ grants eternal life.

To be saved, consider these steps:

1. **Acknowledge Your Sinfulness:** Recognize that you are a sinner, as Scripture states,

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God ~Romans 3:23 AKJB.

Admitting your sin is essential, for without acknowledging it, you cannot receive Christ's forgiveness.

2. **Repent of Your Sins:** Be willing to turn away from sin. God's grace, which brings salvation, teaches us to reject sinful ways and live righteously:

For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men, Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world ~Titus 2:11-12 AKJB.

Repentance involves a sincere commitment to forsake sin, and God provides the strength to live a righteous life.

3. **Believe in Christ's Sacrifice:** Trust that Jesus' death and resurrection paid the penalty for your sins:

But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us ~Romans 5:8 AKJB.

Only Jesus' sacrifice can cleanse you of sin, and only He can save you:

Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved ~Acts 4:12 AKJB.

Accept Jesus as your Lord and Savior, committing to obey His commandments:

If ye love me, keep my commandments ~John 14:15 AKJB.

His yoke is easy, and His burden is light, offering rest to your soul:

Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light ~Matthew 11:28-30 AKJB.

If you are ready to accept Christ, pray to God in your own words, sincerely asking for forgiveness through Jesus Christ. Your prayer must come from a repentant heart, seeking true transformation.

Upon accepting Christ, you are born again, redeemed as a child of God. Obtain a King James Version Bible, join a Bible-believing church, and grow in your faith. If you choose not to accept Christ now, reconsider this vital decision. The opportunity for salvation is available today, but life is uncertain:

(For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation) (2 Corinthians 6:2, KJV).

After death, it is too late to choose Christ. Reflect carefully on this eternal matter.
